PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Fort Hill Infrastructure Services has been retained as a subconsultant to assist the Town of Framingham with a town-wide infrastructure improvement program. In part through funding provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), the Town is undertaking a multimillion dollar project to construct a new water resource center and a new waste water management facility. In addition, the Town is rehabilitating or replacing much of its subsurface water supply and sanitary sewer utility infrastructure. Fort Hill was retained to provide an independent zoning analysis of the new facilities and to provide traffic and parking analysis memoranda for submission to the Planning Board. For the second phase of the project, Fort Hill has been retained to develop a dynamic traffic model to help plan work zones and traffic detours during the subsurface infrastructure phase of the project.
