PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Fort Hill Infrastructure Services was retained as a subconsultant by Special Operations Command South to master plan a new headquarters facility on 90 acres of leased land. Fort Hill is assisting in the preparation of a Real Property Master Plan and Installation Design Guide for a \$43 million military construction project to construct the new headquarters. Using Army Regulations 210-14 and 405-70 as guides, Fort Hill's role in the project is to facilitate an understanding of the end users requirements and to capture the essential elements of the master plan from an end user's perspective. In addition, Fort Hill is preparing the transportation and anti-terrorism/force protection components of the master plan.
